



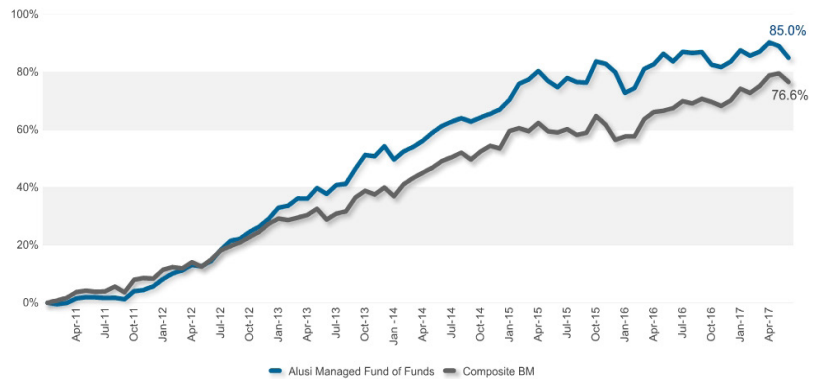

PORTFOLIO AND MARKET OVERVIEW

Global economic growth remains positive, advancing steadily in a more balanced and sustainable manner. Global Corporate profits have responded with some vigour and are recording double-digit gains, well ahead of the slow to negative momentum of the previous years.

US Fed policymakers are feeling increasingly confident that the economy has made substantial progress in moving back toward their dual mandate objectives, and that this progress is apt to continue. They also reiterated that additional hikes will likely be forthcoming if the economy continues to evolve as anticipated.

The positive global developments were unfortunately not reflected in all emerging markets. The South African SWIX Index was flat for the quarter. The resources sector was down 7.24%, while SA Inc. was also down, which was reflective in the Mid Cap and Small Cap indices being down 8.46% and 8.07%, respectively. Industrials was up by 2.35% for the quarter, mainly driven by Naspers, which was up 8.51%.

Q2 2017 Performance

During Q2 2017, the Managed Fund delivered -1.12%, relative to the benchmark return of 0.84%. The biggest contribution to the overall return came from the fixed interest exposure. Whilst the SA equity market was the weakest asset class for the quarter, with a return of -0.4%, our managers lagged the Index for the period with an average return of -2.23%. This was due to their overweight Rand Hedge exposure, which initially detracted for most of the quarter, but came back strongly at the end of the quarter. The property sector returned 1.83% which was in line with cash which had a return of 1.9%.

The investment performance is calculated by taking the actual initial fees and all ongoing fees into account for the amount shown and income is reinvested on the reinvestment date. Other fees include the permissible deductions of brokerage, STT, VAT, bank charges, trustees and custodian fees incurred in the ordinary course of running the Fund.

CIS prices are calculated daily and published daily on the Morningstar website - code ACBCB, ISIN ZAE000153011. CIS prices are calculated on a net asset basis, which is the total value of all the assets in the portfolio including any income accruals and less any permissible deductions (brokerage, STT, VAT, auditor's fees, bank charges, trustee and custodian fees and the annual management fee) from the portfolio divided by the number of participatory interests (units) in issue. A Fund of Funds unit trust only invests in other unit trusts, which levy their own charges, which could result in a higher fee structure for these portfolios. Forward pricing is used.

Funds are valued daily at 16:00. Instructions must reach Alusi before 12:00 to ensure same day value.

Alusi Management Company (Pty) Ltd is a Collective Investment Schemes Manager approved by the Financial Services Board in terms of the Collective Investment Schemes Control Act. The Management Company reserves the right to close the fund to new investors if we deem it necessary to limit further inflows in order for it to be managed in accordance with its mandate.

The Fund's Total Expense Ratio (TER) reflects the percentage of the average Net Asset Value (NAV) of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio.
